

Please Recycle Universal Waste

Universal Waste Items that should **NOT** be placed in your grey trash or blue recycle can include the following:

- ❑ Common batteries
- ❑ Automobile batteries
- ❑ Fluorescent tubes and light bulbs
- ❑ Antifreeze
- ❑ Used motor oil
- ❑ Water-based latex paint
- ❑ Electronic devices such as TV's, printers, computers, cell phones, telephones, radios and microwaves

These items need to be disposed of at Clean Harbors and

DO NOT BELONG IN YOUR GREY TRASH OR BLUE RECYCLE CARTS:

- ❑ Older thermostats with mercury inside
- ❑ Electrical switches and relays found in some chest freezers
- ❑ Pilot light sensors containing mercury
- ❑ Barometers, manometers, blood pressure and vacuum gauges
- ❑ Mercury thermometers
- ❑ Athletic shoes with flashing lights in the soles (manufactured before 1997)
- ❑ Oil based paint
- ❑ Solvents/thinners
- ❑ Propane
- ❑ Household cleaners
- ❑ Electric space heaters with mercury switches
- ❑ Old clothes irons with mercury switches
- ❑ Pesticides

How do I dispose of Universal Waste items that are NOT allowed in the trash cart?

It is probably a good idea, especially for small items like batteries, to place a container in your home and fill the container before taking the items to the drop-off facility. This will save you time and money by making less trips to the recycling facility to dispose of these items.



Batteries and compact fluorescent light bulbs (not fluorescent tubes) can be disposed of at the following Port Hueneme locations:



The City of Port Hueneme does not pick up tires in trash carts or Special Pickups.


Please don't "donate" tires to thrift stores. Thrift stores do not accept used tires. Even if you have good tires, please don't leave them at a thrift store.

BRING TIRES TO TIRE STORES

Many tire stores accept used tires for a fee (between \$1 and \$5), or they will dispose of your old tires free of charge when you purchase new ones.

To find a tire store near you that accepts tires, see "Tire Dealers" in your telephone directory.

Large piles of tires can be removed and recycled by companies such as BAS Tires (909) 383-7050, CRM (310) 538-2222 or others you may find in your local telephone directory.
